SUBJECT: REVIEW OF PROPOSED BY-DISTRICT VOTING MAPS

RECOMMENDATION

The Board of Directors reviews the 3 proposed voting maps and designates 3 voting districts in each map to be up at the November, 2020 election.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

As required by Elections Code Section 10010(a)(1), the District held 2 public hearings on June 5th and June 19th to allow for the public and the Board to provide input regarding the composition of the District's voting districts. Based on the comments provided during those hearings, Redistricting Partners has prepared 3 draft voting maps.

State law requires these maps to be published and made available to the public before the next public hearings, which are set for the August meetings. State law also requires the District to publish the potential sequence of elections for the voting districts.

The Board provided that it did not want the maps to be drawn based on the current Board members' addresses. To ensure the maps were unbiased, Redistricting Partners was not given any Board members' addresses. These addresses will also not be included when the maps are published.

At the June 19th public hearing, the Board provided direction to staff to designate the voting districts up for election in November 2020 based on the current Board members whose seats will be up at that election. However, some of the voting districts in the attached maps contain multiple Board members. Staff requests that the Board review the attached map and designate 3 voting districts in each map. The designated voting districts up for election in 2020 will be noted at the time of publication of the maps but this designation is not final and may be changed by the Board at the August public hearings.

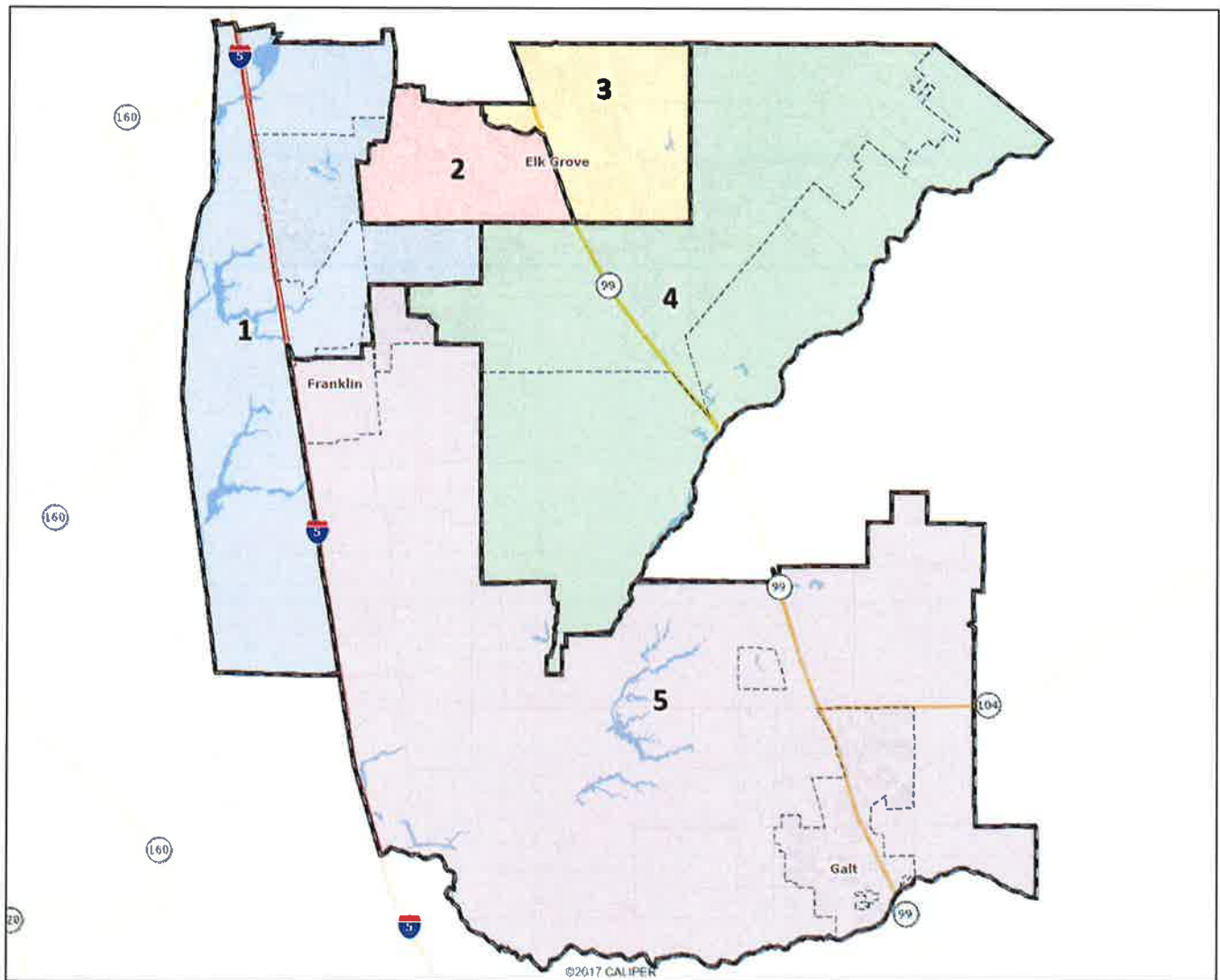

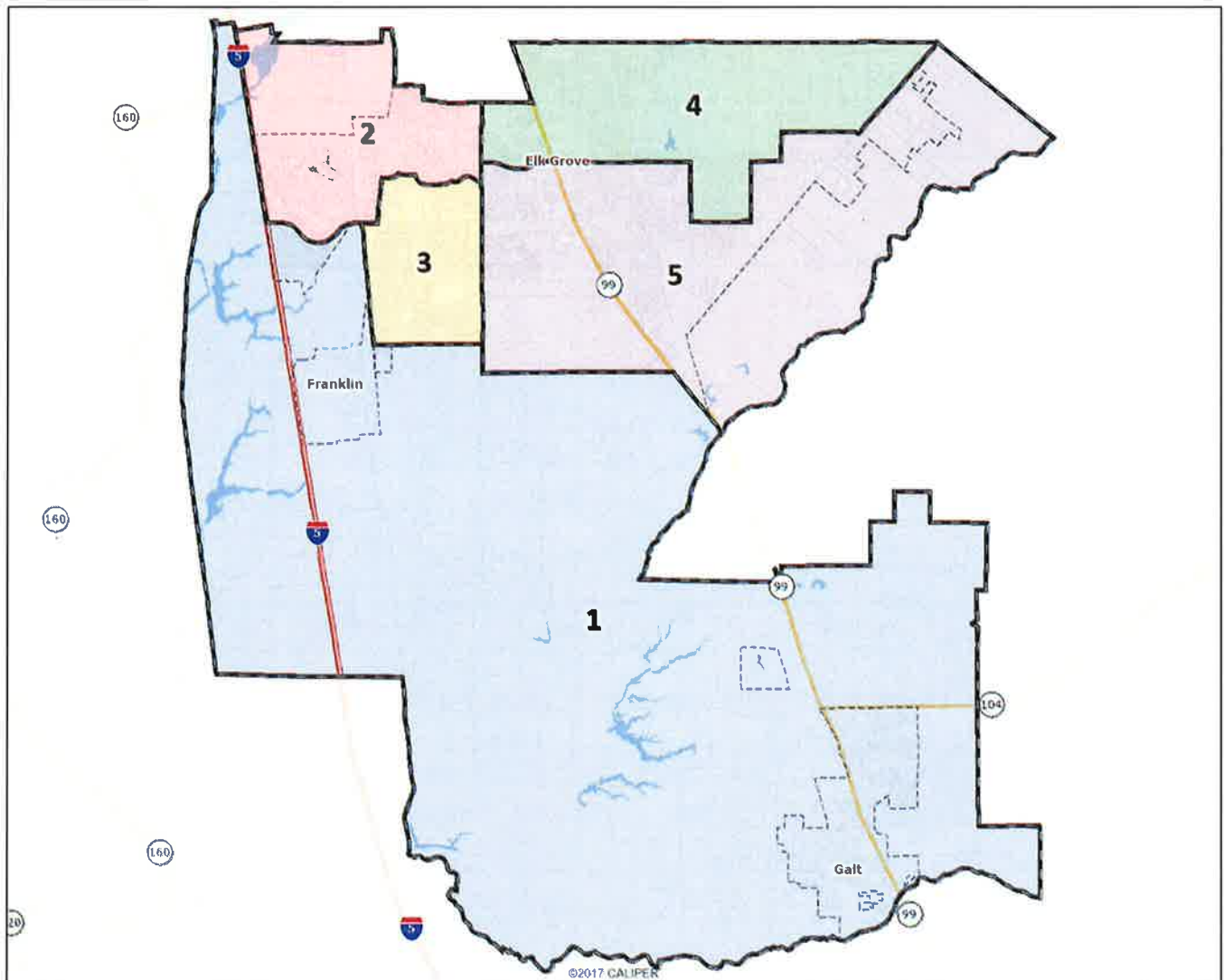

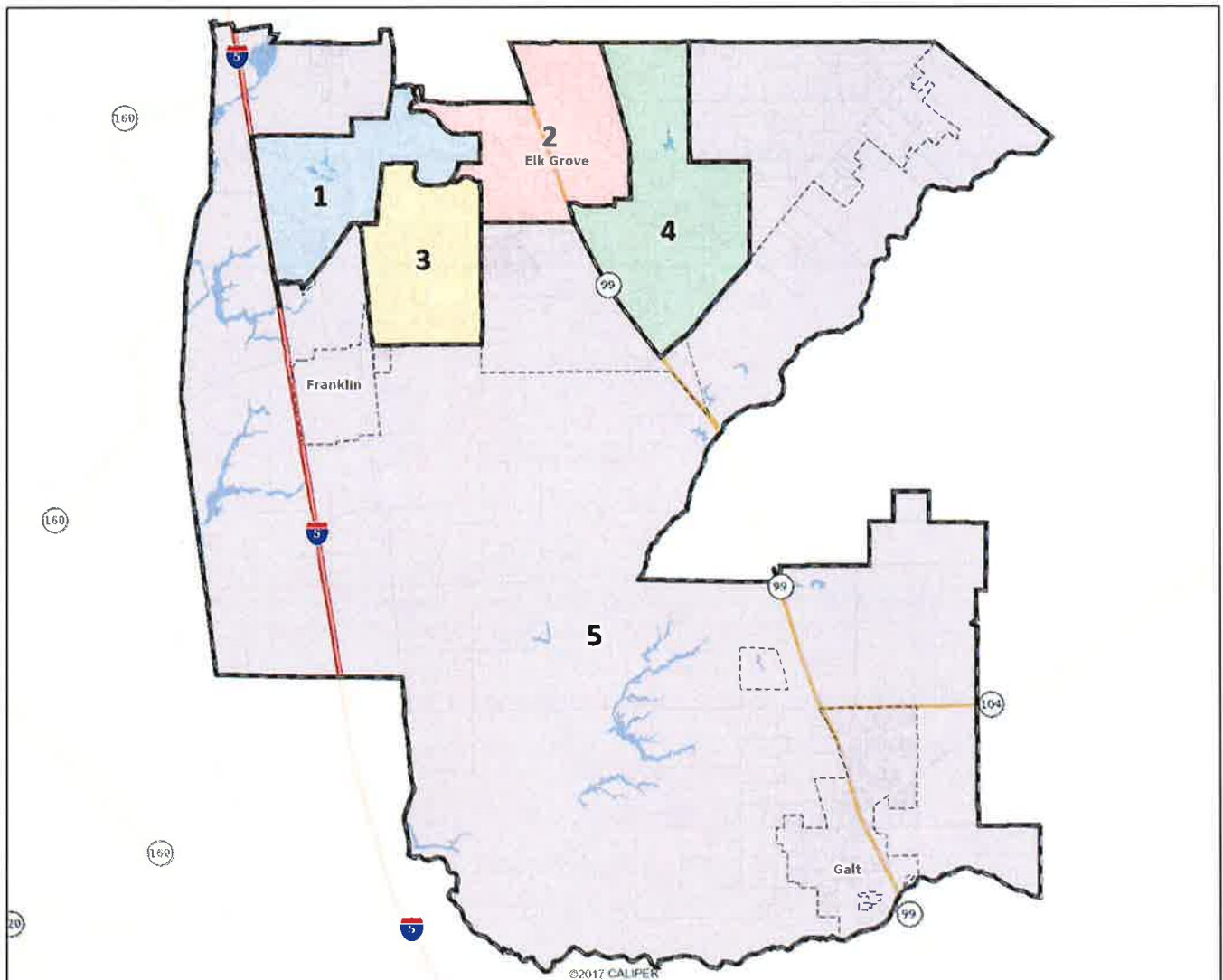
