NOW, THEREFORE, the Cosumnes Community Services District Board of Directors does hereby proclaim May of 2023, as:


ASIAN AMERICAN AND PACIFIC ISLANDER HERITAGE MONTH

and invites staff and the community to learn more about the cultures, people, traditions, and values that have positively enriched the community.


